

## Natalie's Top Thirteen Scriptures on Forgiveness:

**1. Luke 23:24** While hanging on the cross about to die Jesus says "Father, forgive them, for they don't know what they are doing."

**2. In Matthew 6:14-15** Jesus states "For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins."

**3. Ephesians 4:31-32** "Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God has forgiven you."

**4. Matthew 6:9-13 & Luke 11:1-4.**

"Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us."

**5. Mark 11:25** "And when you stand praying, if you hold anything against anyone, forgive them, so that your Father in heaven may forgive you your sins."

**6. Luke 6:37** "Do not judge others, and you will not be judged. Do not condemn others, or it will all come back against you. Forgive others, and you will be forgiven."

**7. Luke 17:3-4** "If another believer sins, rebuke that person; then if there is repentance, forgive. Even if that person wrongs you seven times a day and each time turns again and asks forgiveness, you must forgive."

**8. Hebrews 10:17-18** "I will never again remember their sins and lawless deeds" When sins have been forgiven, there is no need to offer any more sacrifices."

**9. Colossians 3:13** "Bearing with one another and if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other as the Lord has forgiven you so you also must forgive."

**10. 2 Corinthians 2:10** "To whom ye forgive anything, I forgive also; for if I forgave anything, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave I it in the person of Christ; lest Satan should get an advantage of us; for we are not ignorant of his devices."

**11. 1 John 1:9** "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."

**12. Numbers 14:18** "God is slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love, forgiving iniquity and transgression."

**13. Matthew 18:21-22** "Lord, how often should I forgive someone who sins against me? Seven times?" "No, not seven times," Jesus says "but seventy times seven!"

Read and meditate on these verses until they sink into your spirit. You can and will forgive. God wouldn't ask you to do something that you couldn't do or that He wouldn't do. Ask God to help you forgive. Forgiveness is crucial to fulfilling our purpose.
